It is run by a group of experienced people with business and charity backgrounds and fully trained volunteers with a passion for boating.

'Rivertime' is licensed to take up to 12 people including carers and is fitted with a hydraulic wheelchair lift. It takes disadvantaged adults and children with special learning needs and physical challenges for trips along the river.
